## Excel - Rounding Numbers

When creating formulas in Excel there are times when you need to round a number either up or down to make your calculation work properly. Using the increase/decrease decimal from the toolbar to format a cell, row or column will only change how the number is displayed, not the number itself.

Excel gives you various functions to achieve the correct rounding – Round, Even, or Odd.

The format for these functions is ROUND(**number, number of digits**). The **number** can either be a cell reference (A1) or the exact number itself (54.3119). The **number of digits** determines how the number is rounded.

Using the sample number of 54.3119 in A1:

=ROUND(A1,0) Rounds 54.3119 down to 54.  
 =ROUND(A1,3) Rounds 54.3119 to three decimal points to 54.312  
 =ROUND(A1,-1) Rounds 54.3119 to one place to the left of the decimal to 50  
 =EVEN(A1) Rounds 54.3119 up to the nearest even number (56)  
 =ODD(A1) Rounds 54.3119 up to the nearest odd number (55)

These formulas can be embedded in a formula where you need it – such as this example = ((a1\*3)+ROUND(a2,4)). Try these functions for yourself to see how they work.
